HISTORY

In early 2004, Pat Kennedy and a group of fellow early childhood educators decided to take action and try to meet a need that they noticed in the Rockingham community. It had come to their attention that 50% of the children entering kindergarten were unprepared. The literacy levels needed to be raised. This hatched the idea for a "reading road show," a way that literacy could be brought to children who might otherwise have limited access to books. This program would take the form of a bookmobile named "The Gus Bus."

Ms. Kennedy worked with the local schools and the Harrisonburg Police Department to determine which neighborhoods the program could send Gus Bus. Now, the Gus Bus has a route through Harrisonburg. Rockingham, and Page counties. The bus goes to apartment complexes and neighborhoods to allow kids the opportunity to check out books, participate in lessons and hear stories.


